This is to respectfully inform you that I am the Presiding Judge in the suit listed above, Suit No. J8/131/2019 intitutled Ogyeedom Obranu Kwesi Atta VI v Ghana Telecommunications Co. Ltd. and Lands Commission.

I also wish to further inform you that the panel had adjourned the suit for Ruling to Wednesday, the 22nd of January 2020. However, due to the Christmas holidays the panel was unable to hold judgment conference on time. As a result, we have myjoyonline.com had the Ruling adjourned to Wednesday, the 5th of February 2020.
